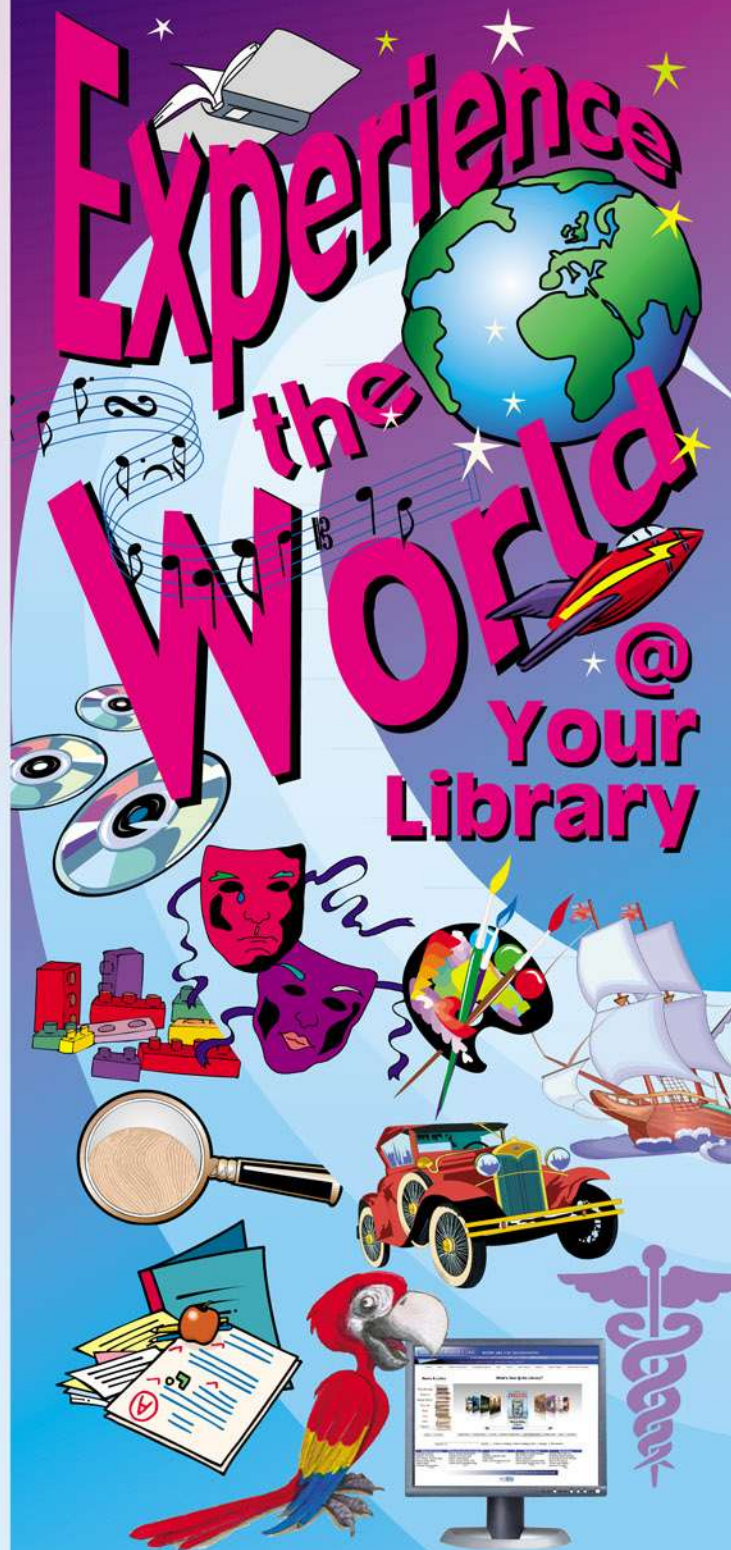

Library Cards

Free to all Pasco County residents, library cards may be obtained by presenting identification verifying current name and Pasco County address (driver's license, Florida ID card, auto registration, printed checkbook, or recent utility bill.)

Renewals

One renewal is allowed for a period equal to the standard loan period, **if the item is not on hold for another patron**. Materials can be renewed by calling any library location, through the web page or by visiting any library location in person. Library users who wish to renew by phone or via the web page are advised to do so in advance of the due date in case their items cannot be renewed.

Lost/Stolen Cards

If your card is lost or stolen, **please notify the library immediately**. Like a credit card, you are held responsible for any activity on your card.
